When students become innovators

Intel® Unnati Catalyst is designed to help you bring out the innovation skills of your students, as they put to use their knowledge and understanding of the technologies they have been learning at your Intel® Unnati Lab.

We will support you as you organise events for your students to work to find solutions to issues and problems that they see around them, using new and emerging technologies.

The entries for the event should be built around technologies that are currently offered under the Intel® Unnati Program—such as AI, AllIoT, FPGA or Smart Mobility—or other new and emerging technologies that are approved by Intel.

Event Guidelines

- The event should be held between May 2022 and March 2023.
- All participants should be 18 years of age or older.
- You are at liberty to open the event to students from institutions other than your own.
- You should submit the Sponsorship Application Form in the prescribed format to our System Integrator Associate at least 30 days in advance of the event.
- The tagline “An Intel® Unnati Catalyst Event” should be displayed along with the event name and/or logo in all promotional material used in all media, except when the event name is used as a part of body text.

Based on the Sponsorship Application Form, Intel India will offer **full or partial sponsorship of awards to the top 3 winners in each event for a maximum of 10 events** during the above period. In the case of a full sponsorship, Intel will reimburse the cost of all awards, whether monetary or material, given for the event, while, under a partial sponsorship, Intel will, at its discretion, choose specific awards to sponsor, based on the technologies involved or other criteria that it considers relevant.

If your institution's event is selected for sponsorship under the Intel® Unnati Catalyst program, our System Integrator Associate will coordinate with you for signing a Sponsorship Agreement that will detail the Terms and Conditions of the sponsorship.

Selection Criteria

- This program is only open to educational institutions that have purchased one or more Intel® Unnati labs.
- The event should be linked to usage of new and emerging technologies. Preference will be given to technology areas for which Intel® Unnati labs are available today: AI, AllIoT, FPGA or Smart Mobility.
- Participating students should have completed 18 years of age as at the date of the event.
- The nature of problem statements, learning outcomes for the students, and the expected number of student participants would be other key factors considered while making the sponsorship decision.
- Intel India's sponsorship would be limited to awards for the winners of the event. **Winners could be**

individuals or teams based on the event format decided by the institution. **Award denominations would be ₹50,000 for First Place, ₹30,000 for Second Place, and ₹20,000 for Third Place.**

Intel India or its authorised vendor will share these awards with the Faculty or Management point of contact at the institution. It will be the responsibility of the institution to ensure that the winners receive the award amounts; and, in the case of a team winning an award, to distribute the award amount among the team members. Once the awards are disbursed, the institution should submit a fund usage report to Intel India.

- The decision to support the event will be solely at the discretion of Intel India. The decision will be conveyed to the institution through the supporting System Integrator within 15 days from the date of receipt of the Sponsorship Application Form.
- Each institution will be eligible for sponsorship support for only one event per calendar year.
